



CHLORINE BLEACH 101

Using Bleach:

- Never mix with ammonia or any other cleaner.
- Wear rubber boots, gloves, and eye protection.
- Try not to breathe in product fumes. Open windows and doors to allow fresh air to enter.

Look for the sodium hypochlorite percentage, if available, in order to create an effective sanitizing solution for pots, pans, dishes, flatware, and countertops.



Effective Sanitizing Solution:

Use a fresh solution of 1 tablespoon unscented 6% bleach or 1 teaspoon unscented 8.25% bleach per gallon of clean room-temperature water. Do not use low splash or scented bleach since they are not strong enough to sanitize.
